Delivery:

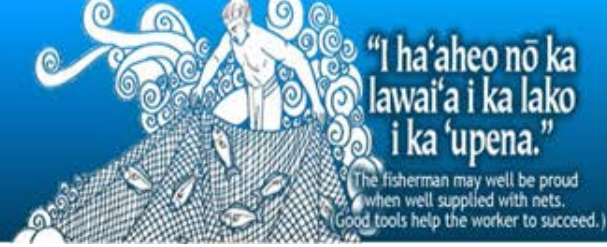
- These workshops integrate culture with the college planning process and will focus on what the student and their ‘ohana need to know in order for student to successfully transition to college.
