- Demonstrate financial need as determined through analysis of complete application

Merit-based scholarships for graduate students. Eligibility requirements:

- Classified, degree-seeking student at an accredited post-high educational institution in the U.S. that is recognized by KS
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0
- Conferred/anticipated Bachelor's degree by Spring 2015
- Meet maximum funding guidelines

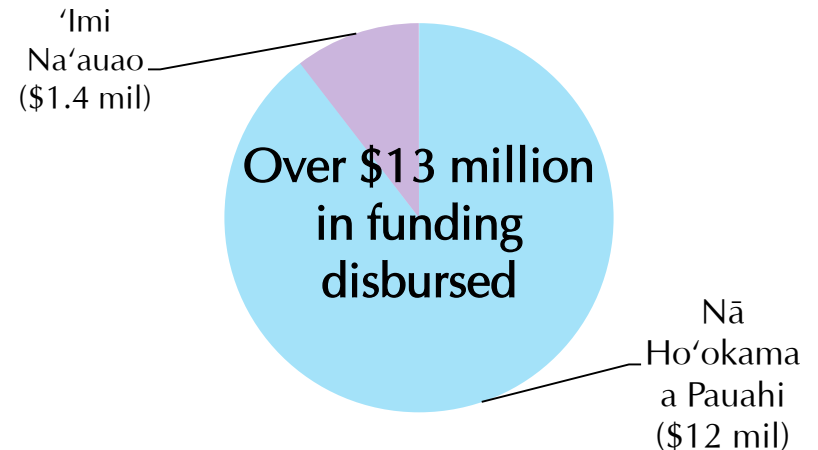
- Merit-based
