Memorial Printed Program Guidelines

The Chapel staff understands the importance and value of proper planning for a loved one's Memorial Service. One of the services we offer is the printing of programs. The family has one of two options. First, the Chapel Staff can prepare and print the programs; as long as the family submits the necessary program information before the designated due date, the Chapel Staff can accommodate the family and have the programs ready prior to the Memorial Service. If all pertinent information is not submitted by the due date, the family will be responsible for printing their own programs using the Bishop Memorial Chapel Program Template provided to them by the Chapel Staff. Second, the family may opt to prepare and print the programs themselves. All programs must use the Bishop Memorial Chapel Program Template.
