Aloha mai kākou,

With the City and County of Honolulu's announcement last week that we are now in Tier 3 of their reopening strategy, I wanted to update you on memorial services at the Bishop Memorial Chapel. Effective March 1, 2021, memorial services at the chapel are permitted with a maximum of 25 individuals.

**Important considerations**

Under Tier 3 designation of the City and County of Honolulu, the maximum individuals allowable are limited to 25, inclusive of officiant and funeral coordinator. Observance of social and physical distancing between persons is required and face coverings are mandatory. Attendees will need to register with the chapel office prior to the event for access to the Kapālama campus. Under current State of Hawai'i law, casket services outside of mortuaries are not allowed. Consumption of food or drink is not allowed at this time. Families will be asked to conduct receptions or fellowship off-campus.
