

Hawaii Pacific Health Internship Program

About the program

Calling all healthcare related majors! Kealakūlia has partnered with Hawaii Pacific Health to offer 10 students, paid internship positions with Hawaii Pacific Health and their network of medical centers in Hawaii, including Kapiolani Medical Center for Women & Children, Pali Momi Medical Center, Straub Medical Center in Honolulu and Wilcox Medical Center on Kaua'i.

This 6-week, paid internship program is designed to provide high school seniors and college students a rare opportunity to gain first-hand experience in the health care industry. Interns have the opportunity to learn more about hospital systems, interact with experienced health care professionals, and experience a variety of different health care professions.

Program Information

- 1. Applicants must be able to commit to the 6-week program
 - o Oahu: June 22-July 31
 - Kauai: June 15-July 24
- 2. Full-time internship only (40 hours/week)
- 3. Application and selection process

Two Steps on Two Websites:

- 1. Complete a short application of interest on the Kamehameha Schools Career Pathways website (available now till March 6): https://apps.ksbe.edu/careerpathways/
- 2. Access the online application at the end of January 2020 via HPH website: https://www.hawaiipacifichealth.org/careers/health-careers-summer-internship/
 - Submit the following: (1) resume, (2) transcript (*note: no GPA requirement, no cover letter),
 and (3) essay completion (1-2 questions)
 - After application is complete, students will be required to complete a web interview
- Selection
 - Selected group of applicants will be invited to an in-person interview
 - Applicants will be asked to confirm their grade level
 - Interview questions will be appropriately geared to the high school and college level students
