The Kamehameha Scholars Kū Ha'āheo Award is an annual award recognizing those Scholars who have demonstrated exemplary participation and achievement in the Kamehameha Scholars program.

Kū Ha'āheo Award Criteria

- Scholars must earn a minimum of 22 points (out of a total of 25 points) for the current school year.
- Scholars may NOT be in RED status in ANY of the four Success Enhancement criteria areas: Scholar Participation, Parent Engagement, Merit Scholarship Assignments, and Mid-Year Grades.

Scholars earning the Kū Ha'āheo Award during each school year will receive their certificate at the start of the following school year. Grade 12 students receiving this award will have their award mailed to them. Please contact your grade level or regional counselor if you have any questions or concerns.
