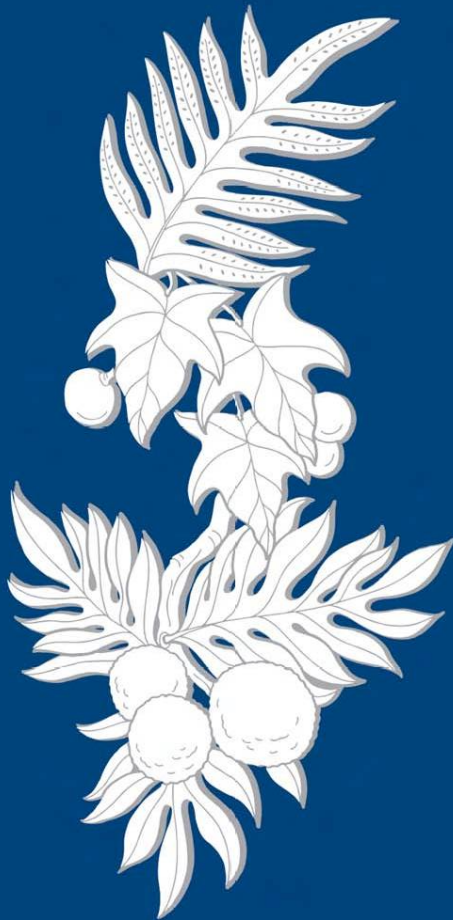


KŪ HA'ĀHEO AWARD

The Kamehameha Scholars Kū Ha`aheo Award is an annual award recognizing those Scholars who have demonstrated exemplary participation and achievement in the Kamehameha Scholars program.

Kū Ha`aheo Award Criteria

- Scholars must earn a minimum of 22 points (out of a total of 25 points) for the current school year.
- Scholars may NOT be in RED status in ANY of the four Success Enhancement criteria areas: Scholar Participation, Parent Engagement, Merit

Scholars earning the Kū Ha`aheo Award during the 2014-15 school year will receive their certificate following the end of the school year, and will also be acknowledged at the start of the following school year. Please contact your grade level counselor if you have any questions or concerns.
