A valuable family and school tradition that occurs at the beginning of each school for all parents of our junior class are the Kūkākūkā sessions. These sessions are designed to bring parents and key high school faculty and administration together in a discussion about important aspects of our students' lives in the upcoming 2 years remaining in high school.

These sessions will be hosted by the class vice principal, grade level and college counselors. Together we will review important elements of the Students and Parent Handbook that impact the day to day school routines of your sons and daughters. Additionally, the team will bring life to some other aspects of student life that provide support and guidance in areas like academic planning, planning and preparing for college search and visits with college representatives; as well as social-emotional support.
