DUAL CREDIT: What is it?

A college course taken by a high school student which allows the student to concurrently earn high school and college credits.



Considerations

- Earn college credits and high school credits at the same time for selected courses
- Open to all students (UHMA: 2.8 GPA min); April Accuplacer testing for Math at Midkiff
- Students must "choose to participate"
- 5.0 grade scale
- Transferability of college credits after KHS
- KS pays tuition, materials, supplies
- Ohana pays registration fee, if applicable (KS Financial Aid covers)
