Welcome to Kamehameha Schools – Kapālama High School! Transitioning into high school is as important for parents as it is for students. To assist you in this process, we have planned your mandatory parent and student orientation in conjunction with your child's first day of school on August 6th, 2018.

Attendance is mandatory and required for the entire day. One Parent/Legal Guardian per student must attend in order for student to be cleared to attend classes. **Please do not send other family members as substitutes, or bring other children/siblings.**

Parent and student will be assigned to one of two groups. You will be receiving information regarding your group assignment in a few weeks which will provide details regarding time and logistics. The Mandatory Parent Student Orientation will begin as early as 7:15am and end as late as 3:30pm. Please plan accordingly.

Throughout the day, you will have an opportunity to meet members of the high school administrative team, and the parent coordinator. They will be sharing knowledge and information that supports a successful transition into high school.

Welina! On behalf of all grade level Vice Principals welcome to Kamehameha High Schools 'Ohana. No doubt you have some questions and perhaps a few concerns. The purpose of this letter is to anticipate and respond to some of your questions and provide information.

- There will be a Mandatory First Day of School “Back to School” on Monday August 6, 2018. Each Student must be accompanied by one (1) parent/legal guardian. On orientation day, you will have the opportunity to follow your child through the scheduled day. Periods are 15 minutes, giving you the opportunity to meet your child's teacher and other parents.

School Uniform

Vendor: Lands' End, store is located in the Nā Lama Kukui building at 560 Nimitz Highway Suite #118, located directly across from Liliha Bakery & Restaurant. Please note that Nimitz Highway fronting Nā Lama Kukui is on way going west bound.

P.E. Uniforms

Purchases must be made at the Kamehameha School Store located on the second floor of 'Akahi. School Store hours are Monday-Friday; 7:00am to 3:30pm, #842-8991. **Grade 9 will not need P.E. Uniforms until second semester.** Grade 10-12 will need uniforms the beginning of semester 1.

Special Events Attire – (Dress Whites for High School Boys)

All items (except white shoes) must be purchased from Lands' End. White shoes can be ordered from www.westernband.com, same vendor that our Kamehameha Band orders from. **The first event requiring dress whites for boarders is Convocation on Sunday, August 12, 2018.**

Special Events Attire – (Dress White Mu'umu'u for High School Girls)

This item must be purchased from Lands' End. White flats or pumps are also required. **The first event requiring dress whites for boarders is Convocation Sunday, August 12, 2018**

School Supplies

Students will receive a supply list for each class during the first week. Standard items may be purchased ahead of time – folder paper, pencils, pens, glue, and scissors.

Student Laptops

Information will be forthcoming in July, 2018. Laptops are distributed approximately one week before school starts.
