Tri-Campus Social - May 23 (Gathering at Kawaiaha'o)

Rehearsals - May 24. All seniors to ride KS buses (board buses at 7:15-7:30am) Baccalaureate Rehearsals start at 8am at Kawaiaha'o Church. A senior photo will be taken on stairs of Kawaiaha'o Church. Students will then return to campus for Commencement Rehearsal at Kekūhaupi'o Gym until 12:45pm. ALL students must park in parking structure.

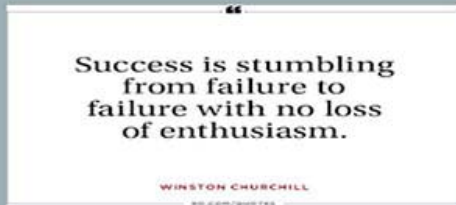
