 - Manage volunteers at each prep day (February 7 and 27). Prep days include working with FLIK staff to cut and prep veggies for kim chee, cut and prep ribs and chicken, mix marinades and sauces.
2. **Online Registration**
 - Manage online volunteer registrations
 - Manage online inquiries
 - Attend Online Volunteer WebSite Training: December 9th at 6pm in the Pauahi Admin lanai conference room.
3. **Day of Ho'olaule'a**
 - Manage volunteers and assign jobs within the booth and help to ensure all shifts have enough coverage throughout the day. The list of volunteers will be provided to each booth
 - Flik staff will be assigned to our booth.
4. **BBQ Grill**
 - Man the grill and manage volunteers throughout the day
 - Flik staff will be assigned to oversee and monitor food safety.
5. **Overall Korean Plate Booth Chair**
 - Oversee all areas of the booth
 - Manage booth decorations - guidelines will be provided
 - Attend required Ho'olaule'a General Meeting on February 4, 2020
