Sophomore Banquet

The sophomore banquet, themed *A Night in Hollywood*, will be held on Saturday, January 25, 2020 from 5:30pm-10:00pm at Kekūhaupi'o Gym. Ticket SALES will be held **ONLINE ONLY** during the week of Monday, December 2. Students may purchase a **maximum of TWO (2) tickets**, one for the student and one for his/her guest (**for banquet, guests must be in high school or no older than 19 years of age**). Ticket costs are as follows:

- (1) ticket for (1) KSK 2022 student = \$18
- (2) tickets for (2) KSK 2022 students = \$36
- (2) tickets for (1) KSK 2022 student AND (1) NON KSK 2022 GUEST = \$40
- NO REFUNDS

Please note that ALL sales must be completed **ONLINE** (debit/credit cards and bank account info *required*). **NOTE: There is a \$2.50 fee due to insufficient funds.**
