Based on the guidelines of our institution, in conjunction with CDC and DOH guidelines, we will continue with our current practice of requiring a face mask and face shield while indoors and only a face mask when outdoors (face shield optional). The research indicated on the CDC website below, highlights the effectiveness of masks for both the wearer and those around:

Please note that we do have a mask exemption policy for students who provide a doctor's exempting them from wearing one.
