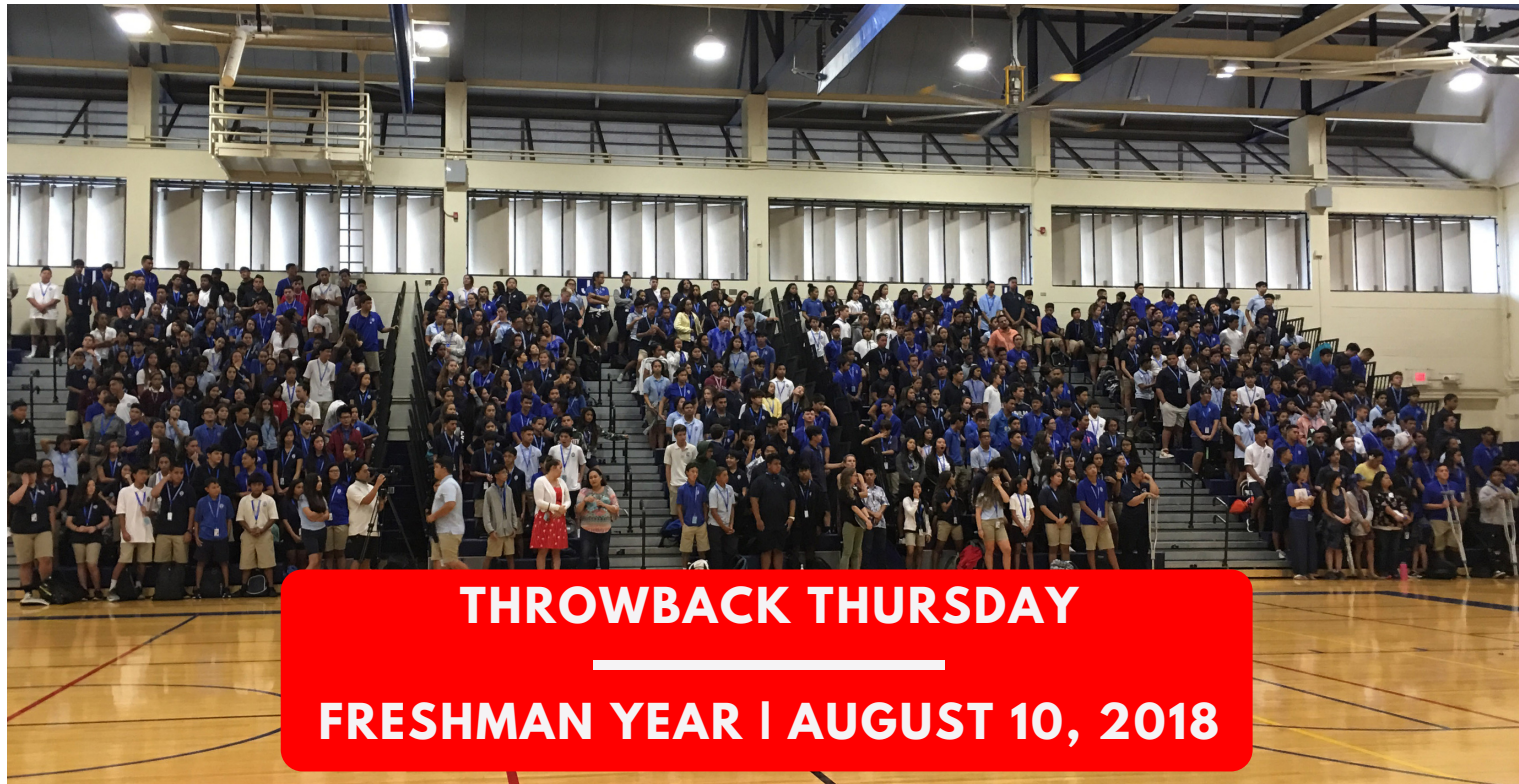

I look forward to helping my nephew Nico's class as I was fortunate enough to have helped my son La'akea's class before him.



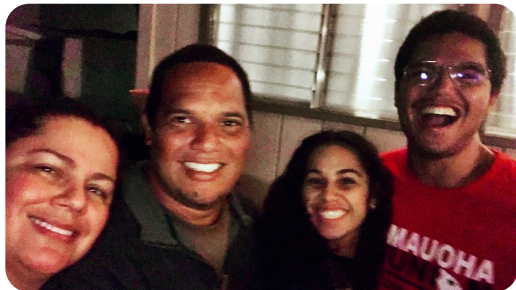
◀ Amalie Monlux, Mother to Kanoa
