All Volunteers MUST comply with Hawaii rules and KSK Visitor Campus guidelines & protocols.

- Visitors must wear a facial mask on campus indoors & outdoors at all times and maintain physical distancing.
- Please complete the KSK Wellness Check-In form before arriving on campus.
- You will be asked to show your Wellness Happy Face.
- COVID-19 vaccinated individuals are exempt from the rapid test process and may proceed straight to the Junior class event where you will be asked to present proof of full vaccination.
- COVID-19 non-vaccinated individuals must proceed straight to KSK COVID-19 Rapid Testing area before reporting to the Junior class event.
 - Location: Princess Bernice Pauahi Admin Bldg, 1st floor lanai area.
 - Monday - Friday between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
 - Upon arrival, you will be asked to register for the rapid test on your mobile device.
 - Rapid test is COVID-19 shallow nasal swab test.
 - Results will take approximately 15 minutes, please account screening time in your schedule.

- Individuals will receive a text message if you are cleared or not.
- If test results are **negative**, you may proceed to the Junior class event, you will be asked to present proof of rapid test results.
- If test results are **positive**, the individual will be asked to exit campus and encouraged to contact their personal physician.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Help Student Leaders set-up and break-down.
- Chaperone in designated assigned locations.
 - Make sure students are well behaved.
 - Not allow students to leave the Social Fall event before 7:00 p.m.
 - Make sure they are not smoking, drinking alcohol or using any illegal substance.
 - Make sure they are social distancing.
 - Make sure they are wearing their face mask at all times.
 - Remind students to wash or sanitize their hands.
- Help pass out bentos or soft drinks.
